

# BATTERSON WINS IN GOLF TOURNEY

## New Yorker Takes Qualifying Round of Atlantic City Autumn Contest

### Second Place in Big Field Goes to Dr. Simon Carr, Who Is Two Strokes Behind Leader

ATLANTIC CITY, Nov. 8.—J. G. Batterson, a New York golfer of prominence, was the medal winner in the qualifying round of the annual fall tournament of the Country Club of Atlantic City, at the Northfield links, today. He turned the notable trick in a field of 101 starters, that included players from all sections of the country.

Second place in the big field went to a Philadelphian, Dr. Simon Carr, his 109 being two strokes behind the leader. Unfortunately, both he and G. A. Crump, who finished with 180, had to withdraw through inability to stay down for the match play, and the Quaker City chances of winning the main trophy are lessened considerably.

Ardin M. Robbins, the old hand from St. Andrew's, and a usually reliable performer over the seashore links, landed in third place, and A. W. Tillinghast and F. F. Briggs, both golfers in the Philadelphia district, easily headed off Hugo Johnstone, the Myopia player who led the Boston hosts in the recent tri-city matches for the Lesley cup.
