

TRISTATE GOLF TOURNEY STARTS

Pennsylvania and Massachusetts Teams Meet Today for Championship

The Tri-State golf contest, started today at the Huntingdon Valley Country Club, Pennsylvania and Massachusetts contesting for honors. The winners will meet New York on Saturday for the championship, and a keen contest is looked for throughout, as all three teams are very strong.

The Massachusetts team was out on the links today and performed very cleverly, and it looks as if the Pennsylvania aggregation would have their hands full today. The women's national championship opens at the Merion Cricket Club on Monday and several fair golfers who accompanied the Massachusetts team, will play over for that event. Four prominent English players are entered, of whom the most conspicuous is Miss Dorothy Campbell, of North Berwick, Scotland, who is paired with Miss Mary Adams, of Boston, the eastern title holder.

The others are: Miss Frances Teacher, also of North Berwick; Miss Sparling, of Barnehurst, and Mrs. R. C. B. Lethbridge, of East Hertz, England. Both Misses Harriet and Margaret Curtis, of Boston, former national champions, are included; also Mrs. Charles S. Stout, of New York, likewise a former United States title holder. Miss Georgianna Bishop, of Bridgeport, is another Metropolitan star in the list who has won the same distinction. The program also has still another ex-national champion in Miss Frances Griscom, of Philadelphia. Miss Katherine Harley, of Boston, present title holder, is in the last pair to start in the qualifying round, the start of which will be at 10 A. M. - The pairs being sent off at four minute intervals, are due to finish at 12:03 o'clock.
