

NEW YORK GOLFERS RETAIN LESLEY CUP

Metropolitan Team Vanquishes
Philadelphians in Tri-State
Match for Trophy.

BEATEN IN THE AFTERNOON

But the Results Had No Direct Bear-
ing on the Early Victory, Which
Clinched the Contest.

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 2. — Defeating Pennsylvania by a score of eight matches to two in the preliminary round of singles the Metropolitan Golf team won the Robert M. Lesley Cup at the Huntington Valley Country Club at Noble to-day. As Pennsylvania had but two points to her credit it was unnecessary to play the five Scotch foursomes scheduled for the afternoon, but this was done to secure a score on the entire tourney.

W. T. West of the Philadelphia Country Club and W. C. Fownes, Jr., of the Oakmont Country Club of Pittsburg were the only members of the Pennsylvania team to win their matches. West defeated Howard Gee one up, and Fownes made even a better showing by carrying off the honors from Fred Herreshoff, 2 up 1 to play. A large gallery of spectators followed the several matches.
