

NEW YORK GOLFERS BEATEN AT MYOPIA

Travis and Tiffany Only Metropolitan Players to Win from Massachusetts.

HAMILTON, Mass., Oct. 1.—The Massachusetts team which defeated Philadelphia yesterday, to-day won the Lesley Cup by defeating the Metropolitan team from New York in the inter-city golf tournament at the Myopia Hunt Club. By winning eight out of the ten singles matches Massachusetts secured such a lead that the playing of the foursomes was not necessary.
