

LOCAL GOLFERS WILL HAVE BUSY SEASON

Philadelphia golfers, both men and women, will be busy this season and the schedule issued by Harrison Townsend, secretary to the Golf Association of Philadelphia, shows that one event will follow after the other from the beginning of May until October.

Few changes have been made in the various events, except in the Philadelphia Cup Series, which will be played under the following conditions.

"In the two-ball matches the winner shall score one point for the match and in addition shall score one-quarter of a point for each hole he is up on his opponent, in the four-ball matches the winners shall score one and a half points for the match and in addition shall score half a point for each hole they are up on their opponents."

The Suburban Cup Competition has been divided into three divisions, A, B, and C, instead of two as previously, each division containing four clubs.

The first tournament will be played at the Huntingdon Valley Country Club on May 30, when the Joseph Henry Patterson Memorial Cup will be competed for. Although Philadelphia does not receive any of the national events, the forthcoming season promises to be even more interesting than any of its predecessors. The men's and women's schedules follow:
