

GOLFERS TO PLAY FOR LESLEY CUP

Howard W. Perrin, president of the Pennsylvania Golf Association, announces that as the result of the play in the tournament at the Philadelphia Cricket Club and the Huntingdon Valley Country Club last week, thirteen men have been selected from which the Philadelphia contingent will be chosen to represent the Pennsylvania Golf Association in the Lesley Cup matches on September 27 and 28.

Teams of twelve a side from the Massachusetts Golf Association, the Metropolitan Golf Association and the Pennsylvania Golf Association will compete for the Lesley Cup, playing singles in the morning and two ball foursomes in the afternoon. This is one of the most important golfing events of the year and since the matches will be played on a local course, local players are naturally anxious to make a good showing.

In order to secure the best possible team, the thirteen men selected by the committee will play again at the Huntingdon Valley Country Club on September 22, to further aid in the selection of the final team. As the Lesley Cup matches are to be played at the Huntingdon Valley Club it will also serve the purpose of giving the men practice in competition over the course.
