

PENNSYLVANIA'S GOLF BEAT MASSACHUSETTS

Metropolitan Team to Play New Englanders in Lesley Cup Finals To-day.

NOBLE, Penn., Sept. 27.—By defeating the Massachusetts team in the first of the Lesley Cup matches over the links of the Huntingdon Valley Country Club to-day by 9 points to 5, the Pennsylvania combination earned the right to play the metropolitan contingent in the decisive match for the trophy to-morrow. The foursomes were decided in a rain in the morning, and the result was a clean sweep for the Keystone golfers. The two-ball matches were suggested by the Massachusetts players, and they were beaten at their own game. Spurred on by their defeat in the first clash, the Bay State wielders of driver and iron managed to take five matches out of ten in the afternoon. The scores:
