

BROOKLAWN GETS TOURNEY

Met. Association Awards Amateur Event to Conn. Club

NEW YORK, Jan. 18 (Special).—For the first time in the history of American golf the Metropolitan Association will this year carry one of its championships into Connecticut. The Brooklawn Club, Bridgeport, was this afternoon awarded the amateur contest. The only other active candidate for the Wykagyl Club, of New Rochelle, although several others offered their courses. Both these clubs have fine new homes, opened last season. The dates are June 13-16. The open was given to the North Shore Club, of Glenhead, Long Island, near Oyster Bay. It is better known as its former Glenwood Club, when it was controlled by the Crescent Athletic Club. The date is July 12-13. It is open to the country. The junior championship went to the Siwanoy Club, Mount Vernon, N. Y., the only one specially requesting it. The assignment is for June 26-27.

These dates, it is considered, should be a warning to the Oakmont Club, Pittsburgh, not to attempt changing the date of the national from September to June.
