

Lesley Cup 'Alumni' Will Have Special Competition on Links

A brand-new tournament feature will be introduced next Fall at the annual tri-State golf matches for the famous Lesley Cup. On a preceding day an eighteen-hole competition will be held solely for Lesley Cup "alumni," the young and old men who have played on Massachusetts, New York or Pennsylvania teams in the past. The cup matches will be held at Philadelphia this year over the links of the Merion Cricket Club, on Oct. 1 and 2. They will be preceded by a 72-hole medal play invitation tourney at Merion, open to golfers of the neighborhood and Lesley Cup players, who are expected to take advantage of that opportunity for practice rounds over the course. In connection with this medal play event the veterans' competition will be held.
