

WHITE NAMED CAPTAIN.

Winner of M. G. A. Golf Title to Lead New York in Lesley Cup Play.

E. Mortimer Barnes, President of the Metropolitan Golf Association, has announced the appointment of Gardiner W. White, winner of the M. G. A. title at Garden City a few weeks ago, to captain the team which will represent the New York area in the matches to be played against the Massachusetts and Pennsylvania golfers for the Lesley Cup. The competition will be held over the links of the Country Club, Brookline, Mass., on Oct. 7 and 8. The cup is now in the possession of the Pennsylvania team, which won it at Philadelphia last year, defeating New York in the final match, 8 to 7.

The members of the New York team last year were Captain Oswald Kirkby, Peter Harmon, Jesse Sweetser, Reginald Lewis, Gardiner White, Frank Dyer, John Anderson A. F. Kammer, A. Lucian Walker and Grant Peacock. It is expected that as a result of the number of newcomers who have come to the top this season the team this year will be considerably strengthened.
