

PENNSYLVANIA GOLF COMBINATION NAMED

Marston Announces Make-Up of Lesley Cup Team—Fownes Slated to Play No. 1.

Max R. Marston, former New Jersey State champion, who will lead the Pennsylvania district golf forces in the Lesley Cup matches, which will be played at the Piping Rock Club tomorrow and Saturday, announced last night the personnel of his team. No. 1 position will probably be played by W. C. Fownes Jr. of Pittsburgh, former national amateur champion and Captain of the American invading team in the British amateur last year. Others on the team are Marcus A. Greer and J. J. Beedle of Llannerch, two former public links stars who performed so brilliantly at Brookline recently; R. S. Kampman of Pine Valley, George Hoffner of Bala, D. W. Corkran of Baltimore, R. A. Lynne of Pittsburgh, winner of the Garden City invitation tournament; Meridith Jack, W. Sargent and John Graham.

It was also announced yesterday that the women vs. men team match would be played on Sunday morning at 10 o'clock at the Garden City Golf Club, Garden City, L. I. The make-up of the men's team is not yet settled, but among those who are expected to play are Jesse Sweetser, national amateur champion; Rudy Knepper of Princeton, runner-up in the Western amateur and semi-finalist at Brookline; Fownes and Jess Guilford of Woodland, former national amateur champion. It was expected that Francis Ouimet, former national open and amateur champion, would be one of the contestants, but the Bostonian notified the committee yesterday that he would be unable to remain over for the match.

Sweetser has a difficult time ahead of him, for announcement was made yesterday that he would pair up with Leonard Martin of Apawamis, the Westchester County junior champion, in a four-ball match at the Wykagyl Country Club course at New Rochelle on Sunday afternoon, Oct. 8, against T. V. Birmingham, the Wykagyl Club champion, and E. E. Sturges of Scarsdale, the Westchester County champion, in an exhibition for the benefit of the New Rochelle Hospital.
