

KEYSTONE LINKSMEN BOW TO NEW YORKERS

Pennsylvania Lesley Cup Team Smothered; Llanerch Pair Only Locals to Win

LOCUST VALLEY, N. Y., Oct. 6.

METROPOLITAN golfers, by defeating Pennsylvania, 13 to 2, in the first of the tri-city matches for the Lesley Cup over the Piping Rock Club links today, won the right to meet Massachusetts, the defenders of the trophy, in the final round tomorrow.

The New York players won four of the five foursome matches in the morning and nine of the individual contests after luncheon.

Playing No. 1 for New York, Jesse Sweetser, the National champion, defeated Max Marston, the Pennsylvania State title-holder, by a comfortable margin in the afternoon, while in the early hours Sweetser, paired with John Anderson, won by 7 and 6 from Marston and W. C. Fownes, the Penn captain.

Only one pair of Pennsylvanians, J. Beadle and Marcus Greer, won in the morning, defeating Oswald Kirkby and Reginald Lewis by 2 up. Beadle also scored for his side in the afternoon, after an extra hole match in which he won from John Anderson.
