

LOCAL GOLF SEASON WILL OPEN APRIL 14

31 Teams Entered in Women's Interclub Title Series

THE largest number of women who ever played in an inter-club competition in this country will usher in the golf season of the Women's Golf Association on Friday, April 14. There are four leagues represented by 31 teams and 167 players. These matches will continue until May 15.

The new competition takes in nine clubs, Old York Road, Philmont and Overbrook entering second teams, while Wilmington, Gulph Mills, Springhaven, Tredyffrin and the Brookside Country Club make up the other teams.

The championship will be played from May 22 to 26 at the Huntingdon Valley Country Club. Mrs. Clarence H. Vanderbeck, former national champion, is the present title holder. The annual competition for the Clarence H. Geist Cup will be played as usual at the Overbrook Golf Club, the date being May 12. One of the new events is the first competition for the Nancy Wilbur Cup at the St. Davids Golf Club on May 17. The Ida E. Dixon Cup tournament will be played at the Springhaven Country Club on May 31.

The Women's National championship will be played at the Green Brier Country Club, White Sulphur Springs, W. Va., from September 25 to 30. Immediately following this will be the annual competition for the Berthelwyn Cup at the Huntingdon Valley Country Club from October 3 to 7. This event was won last year by Miss Glenna Collett, who defeated Miss Cecil Leitch, the British champion, in the first round.

The Fridolyn Cup tournament at the Philmont Country Club, which last year drew more than 400 men and women players, will be played at Philmont on Saturday, June 17, and there is every indication that 500 players will participate in it this year.

Men-Start Play in Club Championship May 17

AS USUAL, the Suburban Cup matches will open the 1922 golf season of the Golf Association of Philadelphia. These interclub matches will be participated in by twenty golf clubs and each team will consist of ten players. The matches will begin on Wednesday, May 17, five men on each of the twenty teams playing at home and the other five playing away from home. For convenience the clubs have been split up into five divisions of four clubs each.

The amateur championship will be played at the Pine Valley Golf Club, from June 7 to 10, and this will be the first event ever held on this famous course. The junior championship, now one of the largest and most important events on the programme, is scheduled for June 26, 27 and 28, at the Torredale Golf Club, while the open championship will be played on July 20 and 21, at the Merion Cricket Club. This year the entire purse will go to the professionals with medals for the amateurs who get into the money class.

The annual dinner tournament, which yearly attracts a field of between 300 and 400 players, will be played on June 15 at the Philmont and Old York Road Country Clubs, with dinner at the former club. The Father and Son tournament is scheduled for September 6 at the Whittemarsh Valley Country Club, while the Seniors tournament, formerly known as the Ancient and Honorable, will be played at the Old York Road Country Club on September 12.

Both the open and the amateur championship of Pennsylvania will be played this year at the Allegheny Country Club on September 12.

The Lesley Cup matches, in which teams representing Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and the Metropolitan Golf Associations play, are scheduled for the Lido Country Club on Long Island, one of the hardest tests of golf in this country.

There will be two new invitation tournaments, one held from June 1 to 3 at the new Green Valley Country Club at Roxborough, and the other at the Aronimink Golf Club, from September 21 to 23. Other invitation tournaments scheduled will be held by the Philmont Country Club, the Huntingdon Valley Country Club, the Philadelphia Cricket Club, the Lu Lu Temple Country Club and the Whittemarsh Valley Country Club. The Country Club of Atlantic City and the Bala Golf Club will also hold spring tournaments.

The national amateur championship will be played this year at the Country Club, Brookline, Mass., from September 4 to 9, and the national open at the Skokie Country Club, Glencoe, Ill., from July 11 to 14.
