

# U. S. G. A. Refuses to Sanction Payment of Expenses for State Amateur Golf Teams

## ADVERSE DECISION WIDENS GAP IN ROW WITH STATE BODIES

Walker Cup, Public Links and Collegiate Matches Only Expenses Allowed by Committee

## OPEN GOLF WAR LOOMS WITH SECTIONAL GROUPS

Fresh fuel was added today to the controversy between the United States Golf Association and several sectional ruling bodies when Prescott S. Bush, secretary of the U. S. G. A. announced that the executive committee by a unanimous vote declined to approve payment of expenses of players representing State sectional teams. The decision came rather unexpectedly as the U. S. G. A. granted the sectional associations a hearing on the issue less than a fortnight ago.

Under the ruling of the U. S. G. A. expenses of amateur golfers may be contributed to or paid in connection with only three competitions, the Walker Cup matches, public links championship and collegiate events. The controversy arose over the recent Lesley Cup matches in Canada when the Massachusetts Association sought to defray the expenses of the team representing that State. The suggestion was not only frowned upon by the national body, but it was hinted any player accepting expenses would seriously endanger his amateur status.

Aid of M. G. A. Sought  
Enlisting the aid of the Metropolitan and Pennsylvania Golf Association, the Massachusetts organization placed its case before the U. S. G. A. claiming that if the national ruling body defrayed expenses of the Walker Cup team, State associations should be allowed as much latitude in regard to teams representing them in inter-sectional competition.

Today's announcement threw down the gauntlet and unless the sectional associations have altered their attitude, a war looms between national and sectional associations.

In his statement, Mr. Bush said: "The committee believes that the best interests of the game require strict enforcement of the present amateur rules and not the creation of further exceptions."

Mr. Bush further stated that a lessening of the pressure now applied to amateur rules "would be opening the door to extinguishing the amateur rule entirely."

Hits Golf Subsidy  
The proposed amendment and its resulting extension to all forms of team competition, continued Mr. Bush, "might easily tend toward commercializing the sport and encourage a group of players whose sole activity might be that of playing on golf teams throughout the country with expenses paid."

"The committee does not believe that amateur golf competitions by teams or otherwise, require subsidy, or that the development of the game in this country demands or quires the creation of a class of paid golfers."

The secretary further stated that this question was brought up three years ago and voted down by the committee.
