## Sweetser, McCarthy and Voigt Among Those so Far Selected From Metropolitan District.

Eight of the twelve golfers who will comprise the metropolitan golfing contingent in the Lesley Cup matches over the Pine Valley Golf Club links at Clementon, N. J., tomorrow and Saturday against the representatives of Pennsylvania, Massachusetts and Canada were named by Stacey Bender, secretary of the Metropolitan Golf Association, yesterday.

Jess Sweetser, who will lead the team, made his selection before the national amateur at Merion, but the remaining four members who will complete the group were as yet unknown last night because of the uncertainty of their making the trip.

Along with Sweetser will be Maurice McCarthy Jr., the metropolitan amateur titleholder; George Voigt, Walker Cup star, and the pick of the district's best, including Eugene Homans, runner-up at Merion; Eddie Driggs, Long Island champion; Eddie Held, T.
