

## NEW YORK LINKSMEN RETAKE LESLEY CUP

CLEMENTON, N. J., Sept. 30

—The New York metropolitan golf team regained the Lesley Cup by winning nine of the ten singles matches this afternoon at the Pine Valley Golf Club.

The team finished the two-day competition with 55 points in capturing the trophy for the third time in four years. Pennsylvania was second with 47 points, Massachusetts third with 27 and Quebec, the defender, fourth with 21.

Pennsylvania had led New York, 24—15, after yesterday's ten singles and by 33 to 26½ after this morning's five Scotch foursomes matches. Bob Gardner and Kenne Gordon of New York had been low in the alternate-drive alternate-stroke play with a 79.

Gardner, a Walker Cup player, scored a 33, 38—71, one stroke over par, this afternoon in winning all 3 points at No. 1 singles, beating, among others, Pennsylvania's Frank Souchak, the eighth-place finisher in the United States Open.
